

## Whispering Woods Condominium Association ID Card Information

This is the time of year when Whispering Wood ID cards must be updated for 2009. Please follow the instructions below so that you can enjoy the recreational facilities at Whispering Woods.

- You **must** bring the enclosed 2009 “PINK” Revalidation Form with you to obtain your 2009 ID and/or sticker. Make sure it is correct and complete.
- From now until May 22, 2009, you can obtain ID cards or revalidations at the Association office Monday – Friday during these hours only: 6:15 PM – 8:45 PM or on weekends from 11:15 AM – 4:45 PM.
- Please renew your validation or have an ID made no later than 8:45 PM on May 22, 2009, to avoid a \$15.00 late registration fee charged for each revalidation!
- From May 23 – September 7, 2009, you can obtain ID cards or revalidations at the Association office during these hours only: 6:15 PM – 8:45 PM, Monday – Friday. No ID’s will be issued on the weekend. The employees are required to be poolside.

### If you already have a Whispering Woods ID card:

- Anyone with a current ID card who needs a 2009 sticker (no charge) must complete the enclosed “**PINK REVALIDATION FORM**” – including updating of all telephone numbers, license plate numbers, etc. Incomplete requests cannot be honored.
- The form MUST be signed where indicated. Each individual receiving a sticker must sign the form. No stickers will be issued to anyone who has not signed.
- Please bring your completed “**PINK REVALIDATION FORM**” and your Whispering Woods ID card(s) to the Association office during the above time periods to obtain your 2009 sticker.

### If you have never had a WW ID card or have lost it:

- If you have never had a card or have lost it, you must come to the Association office during the hours listed above. You will be asked to complete an application, submit \$15 fee per ID card, and have photo(s) taken. All applicants must appear in person for photo(s).
- Please be prepared with a check written to WWCA – no cash is accepted in the Association office.

### Additional information:

- Children 6 years of age and older must have an ID card. If your child has turned 6 since the last pool season, please purchase one at the clubhouse.
- All tenants must have an up-to-date lease on file with the Association, a current Tenant Agreement Form (TAF), and the 2009 yearly, \$220.00 tenant registration fee. The lease dates and TAF information are located on the revalidation form. Proper documentation must be submitted with your revalidation or new card application. LANDLORDS: Please make sure these items are on file and send the revalidation form to your tenants. Incomplete requests cannot be honored.
- Children over 15 may use the weight room if permission is granted by the parents. Parents must sign in the appropriate space on the revalidation/new card form.
- Finally, pool privileges are only granted to those residents whose unit accounts are in good standing. **OWNERS ON PAYMENT PLANS ARE NOT CONSIDERED IN GOOD STANDING.**

**WHISPERING WOODS CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION**  
**2009 POOL RULES**

1. Residents will be required to present their photo ID card when entering the pool area. CARDS WILL BE COLLECTED UPON ENTRANCE TO THE POOL AREA AND RETURNED WHEN LEAVING. These photo ID cards are not transferable and must be revalidated from each year. New residents may purchase cards, or lost cards can be replaced, for \$15 each, at the association office. Please see "2009 ID Card Information."
2. Use of the pool is limited to Whispering Woods residents in good standing and their guests.  
PLEASE NOTE: Owners on payment plans are not considered in good standing.
3. Each unit owner shall be permitted a maximum of four guests per unit per day. Residents must accompany their guests at all times. The fee for guests is \$7.00 per guest per day on weekdays and \$10.00 per guest per day on weekends and holidays. Half-price guest fees will be in effect after 3 PM each day. There is no fee for children 5 years of age and under. All payments must be by check written to WWCA.
4. Each unit will be permitted to purchase up to (2) two seasonal guest passes. The association offers 2 types. You may purchase a \$30.00 seasonal guest pass which cannot be used on weekends or holidays and/or a \$100.00 guest pass which can be used anytime the pool is open. This does not include use of the Clubhouse facilities. PREVIOUS YEAR GUEST PASSES ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR REVALIDATION. SEASONAL GUEST PASSES MUST BE REPURCHASED EACH YEAR.
5. All children under 14 years of age must be accompanied by an adult of at least 18 years of age at all times. When not a parent, an adult may supervise a maximum of two children. PARENTS MUST BE PRESENT AT THE "BABY" POOL WHILE THEIR CHILDREN ARE SWIMMING THERE.
6. The pool will open Memorial Day weekend (Saturday, May 24) and close on Labor Day (Monday, September 1), and the hours are as follows:

May 23, 24, 25, 30, 31, June 6, 7, 13, 14, 20, 21, 2009 (Weekends and Memorial Day only)	10:00 AM - 8:00 PM
June 22, 2009 - September 7, 2009	
Monday through Friday	12 Noon - 8:00 PM
Weekends and Holidays	10:00 AM - 8:00 PM
7. The lifeguards and/or Clubhouse Administrators are empowered to manage the pool area and all instructions must be followed. Failure to adhere to direction will result in the loss of privileges for the remainder of the day and potentially could result in revocation of pool privileges for the remainder of the season.
8. The lifeguard shall have the right to close the pool because of inclement weather, mechanical failure, or other unhealthy or unsafe conditions.
9. Admission to the pool shall be denied to anyone unfit to swim for reasons of health or unruly behavior.
10. No animals are permitted in the pool area.
11. Toys will not be allowed in the main pool.
12. NO flotation devices are allowed in the DEEP END of the main pool at any time. Only the following flotation devices are permitted in the remainder of the main pool:
  - Foam "noodles"
  - Swimmies: with parent present in the pool at all times.
  - Personal safety devices: (such as life vests) with parent present in the pool at all times.
  - Infant tubes with seats: with parent present in the pool at all times, Monday through Friday only.
13. All residents and guests are expected to conduct themselves in a proper manner and to refrain from loud noise, which may disturb other residents.
14. Showers are required before entering the pool. Bathing suits are required in the pool at all times. Persons wearing any other type of clothing will not be permitted in the pool.

15. All untrained children must wear diapers. Disposable and cloth diapers are allowed in either pool but the child MUST be wearing rubber pants, as per the N.J. Sanitary Code.
16. Swimming (or being in the pool area) is prohibited unless a lifeguard is on duty.
17. Children under 14 years of age must pass a swim test to the satisfaction of the lifeguard on duty to be able to swim in the adult pool unaccompanied.
18. All persons using the pool do so at their own risk. Whispering Woods Condominium Association assumes no responsibility for any accident or injury in connection with such use or for any loss or damage to personal property. Persons using the pool area agree not to hold the Association liable for any actions of whatever nature occurring within the pool area.
19. Eating or drinking is not permitted in the pool or at the edge of the pool. No glass of any kind is permitted in the pool area. Food will only be permitted in the grassy areas and at tables. You are expected to clean up and dispose of all garbage. No alcoholic beverages are permitted. Recyclable products must be separated and disposed of in designated receptacles.
20. No running, punching, wrestling, throwing of any objects or "horseplay" will be allowed in the pool area. Small hand-held toys will be allowed at the pool. Users agree to abide by the judgment of the lifeguard regarding restriction of water toy usage. No Super Soakers, or similar products, of any size are allowed at the pool.
21. No one under the age of eighteen is permitted to have a guest accompany them at the pool without supervision of an adult.
22. These regulations will be posted in the pool area. The failure of any unit owner/resident to abide by these regulations can result in the temporary suspension of membership privileges and/or fines. Violations of these rules should be reported in writing to the Association.
23. Unit owners are responsible for the actions of their tenants, children and/or guests at all times.
24. Volleyball playing will be allowed in the pool at the discretion of the lifeguards.
25. For safety reasons, diving is permitted only from the mat at the deep end of the pool. No running dives are permitted. Forward diving only (no back dives).
26. Use of the spa is restricted to WWCA members and their guest. Children under 14 years of age are not permitted in the Jacuzzi. Children 14 – 17 years old must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
27. PARENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR CHILDREN AT ALL TIMES. Parents must be present at the "baby" pool while their children are swimming there. Infants and children who have not passed the swimming test may swim in the adult pool ONLY WHEN ACCOMPANIED IN THE WATER BY A PARENT.
28. The pool workers do not have change to handle requests for soda machine money. Please come prepared to pay for your guests by check and bring change for the vending machine.



## POOL PROCEDURES

1. Check ID - make sure they have 2009 stickers (children 6 – 13 get RED stickers) (14 and older are YELLOW)
2. Check delinquency report
  - May pay for arrears in checks only, maximum \$500 in arrears to be taken at the pool
3. Guests:
  - Children 5 and under do not pay
  - Maximum 4 per unit
  - \$10 per guest weekends and holidays
  - \$7 per guest weekdays
  - (1/2 price after 3 PM any day)
  - Single Occupancy Guest Passes (SOGP) are always good for one free guest and the guest must be with the resident whom holds the pass.
  - Maximum 2 children per adult if adult is not their parent
  - **Through service as Board members or Committee Chairpersons, certain units are allowed free guests – see list below.**
